Analysis of Demographic Data Standards of Brazilian Instruments Employed In Psychological Assessment of Personality

Abstract

Brazilian tests are evaluated for their effectiveness and efficiency by the Federal Council of Psychology, with a view to its indication for use in national territory. Inventories have been identified (Typological Assessment Questionnaire, Personality Inventory, Personality Scales Comrey and Scale Factor Adjustment/Neuroticism) psychological assessment and normal personality on which they were sought information pertaining to key demographic indicators used. The results show that the taking of demographic information is secondary to the process of standard setting instruments. It is known that the crossover between the various demographic variables allows the precise knowledge of the various characteristics of a population in a given geographical context, enriching the power to analyze the results. There is a discrepancy between what is shown as standard instruments and the characteristics of certain regions of the country and its people.
